PROJECTS:

Church of Christ in Thailand AIDS Ministry

Over the three years, 2009-2011, Uniting Church SA is funding a church and community foster care programme for children with parents affected by HIV/AIDS. Already ten congregations have been trained and are offering care to children whose parents are too ill to care for them or who have died from HIV/AIDS. The "My Story" project involves scrapbooking and storytelling for adolescents who are living with HIV/AIDS and who must come to terms with the harsh reality of their condition.



North Korean TB Hospice

The Presbyterian Church in the Republic of Korea is one of our SA partner churches. Our support of a project in North Korea is an opportunity to provide encouragement for them as they minister to people in the north of the deeply divided Korean Peninsula. Mr and Mrs Hong, of the Korean Church of Melbourne, have worked in Rason City, North Korea, since 2002. Establishing an adequate TB hospice is a vital part of their work.

UAICC – OZ-iwi and Ninti Time

Our Congress project this year is based in Port Augusta. "OZ-iwi", will bring together young people from the Congress and the Evangelical Maori Fellowship of Aotearoa, NZ at an Easter Youth Leadership Training Camp in Port Augusta. Ninti Time is an after school program for primary school children. "Ninti" means "clever" and involves offering children and their parents the Good News in stories, songs, dance, language and lots of fun.
